1. Guidelines for Proposal Submission

- You can also choose to submit proposals for Korean sessions. However, approximately 10 presentations will be accepted to Korean sessions.

2. Types of Presentation

- There are two types of presentation: 1) concurrent sessions and 2) student papers.

[Concurrent session]

- ▶ The proposals submitted for concurrent session will be evaluated into either full paper or brief paper. The review will be based on the scientific quality in the basis of the significance of the findings and maturity of research for the full paper.
- ▶ Full papers (25 minutes) / Brief papers (15 minutes)

[Student paper] (15 minutes)

- ▶ It is for student participation. The presenter should be a first author even though collaboration with professor(s) is acceptable to submit. Best paper award will be given by session mentors' evaluation of presentation skill and clarity of study. No Korean presentation.

3. Paper submission guidelines

- Concurrent session (full and brief): 5 pages maximum
- Student paper: 3 pages maximum
- Submission template will be provided with the notification of acceptance
