### Continuing Education

In Nevada, the State Board of Architecture, Interior Design and Residential Design requires each architect, in order to renew their license to practice in the state, to achieve 8 Continuing Education (CE) / Health Safety Welfare (HSW) credits, 2 of which must be Codes and Codes related. AIA works in partnership with the Nevada State Board of Architecture, Interior Design and Residential Design in order to provide opportunities to achieve these credits.

- o AIA architect members are also required to achieve 18 AIA C.E. credits in order to maintain their membership in the Institute. Through our member meetings, lectures, seminars, charettes, workshops and other opportunities, AIA Las Vegas provides ample opportunities for architects to acquire all their necessary C.E. Credits they need for licensure renewal in Nevada and in most other states.

- o In addition, each year, AIA Las Vegas joins with the Nevada State Board of Architecture, Interior Design and Residential Design (NSBAIDRD) to provide 2 full-day seminars through which AIA members can achieve all the necessary codes related credits to meet the state requirement for license renewal in Nevada (as well as other states).
