Entries will be taken up to 8:15am on the day of the match.

**Time:** Squading begins at 8:00am (Relay pairing and Target assignments)  
1<sup>st</sup> relay Prep time starts at 8:25am  
Shooting begins at 8:30am  
Shooting ends between 1:00-5:00

**Affiliations:** Open to the public. NRA membership is required

**Classifications:** NRA classifications are used.  
New shooters will shoot as "Unclassified" and scored in the Master's class  
until they have logged 120 shots in a temporary log book and/or receive  
their classification from the NRA.

**Minimum Equipment Required:**

- Any center fire Rifle
  - with iron sights (Match or Service Rifle\*\*)
  - Service Rifle with scope – magnification of 4.5X and a maximum objective lens of 34 mm
  - Match Rifle with scope – unlimited magnification and no limitation on objective lens size
- Eye Protection
- Ear Protection
- (2) 5 round Magazines or (2) 10 round Magazines (this will depend on Match or service rifle\*\*) due to NJ laws & the difficulty with owning/having 20rnd mags we allow the use of 10rnd mags for the matches.
- Ammunition – 88 to 130 rounds
- Scope or Binoculars
- Chair (optional)

**Advanced Shooters Equipment:**

- All of the above plus
- Shooting Mat
- Shooting Jacket
- Shooting Glove(s)
- Shooting Stool
- Shooter's Data Book (optional)

**Match Description:**

The National Match Course follows current NRA rules.

The 80NMC (Approved NRA match) will run as 2 relays.

Course of fire is:

Stage 1: Slow fire @ 200yds, 20 rounds in 20min – offhand (standing position, no slings)

Stage 2: Rapid fire @ 200yds, (2) strings of 10 rounds in 60secs each – sitting position

(Requires a reload during the course of fire)

Stage 3: Rapid fire @ 300yds, (2) strings of 10 rounds in 70secs each – prone position

(Requires a reload during the course of fire)

Stage 4: Slow fire @ 300yds (simulated 600yrd target), 20 rounds in 20min – prone position

All stages are preceded by a 2 min sighting in period (2 rnds in 2 mins)

**Awards:**

Cash prizes will be given for each match.

Each match will have a: Match winner, awarded 2pts

1st place in each Classification, awarded 1pt

Each point will be assigned a cash value based on:

(match fee - overhead)/total points

\*\* you will need to consult the NRA rule book for an exact ruling of a Service Rifle vs a Match Rifle, but in a brief description:

A Service Rifle must have the same exterior silhouette as a standard issued US military rifle. (some internal modifications are allowed). [ie: M16 (A2 or A4), M14 (M1A), or M1 (Garand)]

A Match Rifle is any other rifle in any caliber, but must have iron sights.

Space gun (match rifle) is usually an AR based rifle with a fully adjustable stock and iron sights.
