

## Military Bolt Match

### Military Bolt Match - 200 yard line

#### **Equipment:**

1. Any bolt action rifle developed and used by armies between the late 1880s and World War II. This includes straight pull rifles. Sights should be original (no telescopes), slings may be American leather or web, or may be of original nation's design.
2. Competition coats, gloves, mats and spotting scopes are all allowed.

#### **Course of Fire:**

1. Target is the military "Dog Target".
2. All stages start with the shooter in firing position
  - a. 3 minute preparation period
  - b. 5 minutes of sighting shots
  - c. 10 minutes, 10 shots, prone slow fire
  - d. 60 seconds, 10 shots prone rapid fire (must include a clip reload)
  - e. 60 seconds sitting rapid fire (must also include a clip reload)
  - f. 10 minutes, 10 shots standing slow fire (sling may be used in all positions)
3. Positions must be as described in High Power rule book. *For example:*  
No artificial support; foot may not rest on wood at front of the firing line; forearm may not rest on ground in prone position.
