Important information for Arizona Nonprofits that receive funding through state contracts.



Alliance members who provide healthcare and human services to individuals covered by AHCCCS, including ALTCS, and the Division of Developmental Disabilities have told us that in order to receive increased reimbursement for the services provided due to Prop. 206 and Prop. 414, a corresponding state general fund increase will be necessary.

If this applies to you, it is important that you let the Governor's office and State Legislators know about the impact Prop. 206 and Prop. 414 will have on your organization, staff and clients/members, as well as why increased state funding is necessary in order to compensate for the required operating expense increase.
