### **Dr. Clois E. Kicklighter**

**Dr. Clois E. Kicklighter** has a long history of leadership in the Association of Technology, Management, and Applied Engineering (formerly NAIT) including serving as President of NAIT in 1986-1987, President of the University Division in 1987-1988, Chair of the Executive Board in 1988-1989, Chair of the Board of Accreditation from 1990 to 1998, and Chair of the NAIT Foundation from 1998 to 2001. This leadership, along with the other positions he has held in the Association have been recognized by NAIT over the years as follows: 1981 Outstanding Regional Director Award; 1987 Outstanding Service Award for President of NAIT; 1988 Outstanding Service Award for President of University Division; 1989 Outstanding Service Award for Chair of the Executive Board; 1992 Charles Keith Medal; 1995 Exemplary Service Award for Chair of Board of Accreditation; and, 1998 NAIT Honorary Membership.

Clois received a B.S. in Industrial Education from the University of Florida, an M.S. in Industrial Education from Indiana State University in 1963, and an Ed.D. in Industrial Education from the University of Maryland in 1966. His teaching and administrative experience includes positions at Indiana State University from 1962-1963, University of Maryland from 1963-1966, Eastern Michigan University from 1966-1983, and Indiana State University from 1983-1998. His final position before retirement was Dean of the School of Technology and Professor of Construction Technology at Indiana State University.

His many accomplishments include the authorship of numerous books and articles in architecture, construction, drafting, woodworking, crafts, restoration, certification, curriculum, and research. He has served on the Board of Directors for Goodheart-Willcox Company, the Indiana Manufacturing Extension Center, the Governor's Advisory Committee for Developing a Long-Range Technology Strategy for the State of Indiana, the Indiana Governor's Task for Marketing Education and Training Internationally, and numerous other positions.
