Gregory, Lecorgne to Fill Vacant BCA Board Seats

Broomfield, Colo. – August 8, 2008 – The [Board of Directors](#) of the [Billiard Congress of America](#) (BCA) announces that it has appointed Tom Gregory, of [Toltec Lighting](#), and Greg Lecorgne, of [Dave & Buster's](#), to fill two vacant Board seats for the 2008-2009 Board year. Gregory will fill the open Manufacturer/Distributor seat and Lecorgne will fill the open Room Operator seat. The BCA Board made its appointment decision during its recent Board meeting, which was held August 5-6, 2008, in Lake Forest, Illinois.

The directors appointed to fill these vacancies shall serve until the next general election, at which time a successor director shall be elected to fill the remaining terms of office. As such, Gregory and Lecorgne will serve until the next general election in June of 2009.
