QUALIFICATIONS

To apply for board certification you must:

- Be a current MGMA member
- Pay a one-time application fee
- Have 2 years of healthcare management experience with 6 months in a supervisor role

CERTIFICATION STEPS

Completing your CMPE distinguishes you from your peers. Showcase your knowledge and skills by fulfilling three requirements:

- Multiple Choice Exam: A 175, multiple choice test assessing your on the job knowledge of group practice management principles
- *Essay Exam: 3 scenarios to assess your in-depth knowledge of medical practice principles and issues, problem-solving and decision making
- Complete 50 hours of continuing education

**The essay exam will be transitioned to a scenario-based, objectively scored exam in September 2017.*
