Make sure to submit a signed Expectations and Commitments form with the application and provide all required attachments. If a grant application doesn't receive an 80% by our review team, we will provide feedback and let groups submit again. IF that application still doesn't receive an 80% we will ask groups to wait 6 months before resubmitting for a planning grant. It is highly recommended that you reach out to [Lori Ventimiglia](#) before filling out the application to determine eligibility.

State Assessment Update: Charters Must Request Paper Test Options through their Authorizer ASAP

We have been notified by the Colorado Department of Education that for the spring 2015 administration, charter schools will have the opportunity to administer paper assessments for all grades for mathematics, for grade 3 in English language arts, and for students who require the paper-based form due to accommodation needs (ex. students are unable to take the computer-based form due to neurological conditions).

If you wish to take advantage of this paper option, you must notify your authorizer as soon as possible. Your authorizer will need to make the request to CDE on your behalf no later than mid-November.

Resource of the Month: Deals and Discounts

Assessment Tip: Clarification on the READ Act

The State Education Department sought legal guidance from the Colorado Attorney General's office concerning whether the READ Act can be waived under either the Innovation Schools Act or the Charter Schools Act. It has been determined that the READ Act cannot be waived by either innovation or charter schools as the results of this assessment are a portion of the formula used to determine the performance rating of all schools in Colorado, to include charters. However, charter schools can seek a waiver from the state approved school readiness assessment to be given at the Kindergarten level. Any waiver request concerning assessment of school readiness would need to be accompanied by a replacement plan that meets the intent of the law.
