## Welcome to the 2015 Legislative Session: League Legislative Priorities and Communications Channels

Happy New Year and welcome to the 2015 Colorado Legislative Session!

The Colorado League of Charter Schools has been gearing up for the 2015 legislative session over the past few months. We are excited to share with you our policy agenda and priorities for the upcoming months, as well as our plan to keep you in the loop as events unfold at the Capitol.

### Governmental Affairs Committee

Again this year, the League convened a Governmental Affairs Committee made up of representatives from Colorado charter schools and local policy partners. ### League Policy Priorities

Working in close conjunction with our Governmental Affairs Committee, we developed a 2015 policy agenda that is focused on four main areas: Funding, Facilities, Flexibility, and Assessment and Accountability. ### Legislative Updates

Throughout the 2015 session, we will provide you with the following legislative updates to keep you up to speed on events at the Capitol:

- **Webinars**

We will record and distribute periodic webinars that you can watch at your convenience for a more in-depth look at the legislative latest.

- **Action Alerts**

If something arises at the Capitol that needs immediate action, we will use the [Charter Advocacy Network \(Colorado CAN\)](#) to send Action Alerts asking you to contact your legislator to make your voice heard about charter related issues.
