Mayor Harry W. Rilling, was born and raised in Norwalk, CT and spent his professional life as a member of the Norwalk Police force, including 17 years as Chief. In November 2013, he was elected to his first term as Mayor of Norwalk. In the first eight months of his tenure as Mayor, he has vigorously engaged citizens by welcoming their thoughts, ideas, and specific comments on matters in need of attention.
