**MICHAEL J. WILL, MD, DDS, NAMED 2015 PRESIDENT
OF THE AMERICAN ACADEMY OF COSMETIC SURGERY**

CHICAGO, IL – Michael J. Will, MD, DDS, FACS, has been named President of the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery (AACS). Dr. Will was officially inducted on Jan. 17 at the AACS 31st Annual Scientific Meeting in New Orleans.

“I am humbled and honored to be selected to serve as the 25th President of the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery,” says Dr. Will. “I look forward to serving our members by increasing the value of membership and providing expanded educational opportunities and positioning the Academy to be the flagship organization for the specialty of cosmetic medicine and surgery.”

A board certified oral surgeon, cosmetic surgeon and dental anesthesiologist, Dr. Will has been the Medical Director of Will Surgical Arts in Urbana, Maryland, since 2006. He also currently serves on the medical staffs at Shady Grove Adventist Hospital, the Montgomery Surgery Center and Frederick Memorial Hospital.

He is retired from the US Army with over 20 years of service as a maxillofacial and cosmetic surgeon. He completed his General Surgery and Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery training at Brooke Army Medical Center in San Antonio, Texas. His final military assignment was spent as Chairman, Residency Program Director and Consultant to the Surgeon General at Walter Reed Army Medical Center.

He possesses an impressive list of titles within the industry, ranging from Fellow at both the American College of Surgeons and the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology, to Board Examiner of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, among others. Dr. Will received his Bachelor's degree with honors from Washington and Jefferson College in Pennsylvania, his dental degree with honors from Georgetown University School of Dentistry and his medical degree from the University of Texas, where he was inducted into the Alpha Omega Alpha medical honor society and was ranked at the top of his class. Additionally, he completed a General Cosmetic Surgery Fellowship with James D. Billie, DMD, MD, at the Cosmetic Surgery Center in Little Rock, Arkansas.

A nationally recognized lecturer in maxillofacial and cosmetic surgery, Dr. Will is also the distinguished author of numerous textbook chapters and scientific articles, with publications that include “OMS Knowledge Update” and the “CMF Hyperguide.”

He currently lives in his home state of Maryland with his wife Debbie. They have two grown sons, Andrew and Brian.
