

Structured Literature Search and Communicating with your Librarian Co-author

- All Clinical Inquiries require a structured CI literature search. FPIN's Librarian Editor or an FPIN Librarian will perform your literature search. If an FPIN Librarian is available at your institution, please let the PM know during the question signup process. The literature search **MUST** be performed by an FPIN Librarian who will also serve as a co-author. **An FPIN Librarian is defined as a librarian that has been certified or approved by the FPIN Librarian Editor.**
- Your assigned FPIN Librarian will be listed as co-author, assuming they fulfill their responsibilities as a co-author. This includes collaborating with you to define, complement and refine your initial search, conducting the structured search, communicating the search results, doing additional searching as agreed to with you, reviewing the manuscript for accuracy, formatting the references, and providing a copy of the search strategy used for this question for online publication with a link from the published CI. **The search results must be submitted to the CI project manager at ci@fpin.org.**
- If, during the writing process, it is discovered that additional resources are required, please contact your librarian for assistance.
