



FPIN'S NEW EDITORIAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Features:

- 1** Secure cloud based manuscript submission process.
- 2** Monthly HDA activity reports. Reports can be sent automatically to one FPIN point person to track manuscripts in process.
- 3** Electronic calendar due date options for Outlook, iPhone, and any other calendar reminder system compatible with iCal attachments.
- 4** Improved communication and accountability. Only one faculty corresponding author per manuscript will be allowed to manage and track each HDA.
- 5** Streamlined and automated peer-review process. Qualified peer reviewers will be invited, asked only to complete a check-list, and given feed-back within the system.
- 6** Efficient editorial process. Authors will receive their peer review and the first round of editorial review at the same time. In addition, authors and editors will now communicate directly within the EMS (Editorial Management System).
- 7** Easily accessible correspondence history — no more email.
- 8** Faster turn-around and time to publication.
