

Welcome to the Georgia Bio Legislative Watch, a weekly update on the 2012 legislative session of the Georgia General Assembly provided by Brock Clay Attorneys exclusively for Georgia Bio members.

The third week of the 2012 session of the General Assembly was relatively quiet as the legislature moved from budget meetings into regular legislative business. Most of the committee meetings that had been previously scheduled this week were cancelled.

**Senate Politics**

The situation with the Senate Republican caucus seems to have reached an uneasy truce. The most recent development occurred at the end of the first week of the legislative session. The caucus met and took what amounted to a vote of confidence on the current leadership structure. The motion passed 23-13, which has resulted in relative quiet as the Senate seeks to move on to more important issues.

**Georgia Bio Annual Legislative Reception**

Georgia Bio's annual legislative reception was held the morning of Wednesday, 25 January from 8-10. The attendance was excellent with more than 50 legislators and staffers including Senate Rules Committee Chairman Don Balfour, Rep. John Burns, Rep. Charlice Byrd, Chairman Calvin Hill, and Chairman Amos Amerson.

**Venture Capital Legislation**

HB 718 is sponsored by Rep. Allen Peake (R - Macon). It will set up a \$200 million venture capital fund by auctioning insurance tax credits. The fund would be overseen by a state authority and would invest in start-up or early growth technology companies. The legislation passed out of its subcommittee into full committee this week.

**Red Tape Watch Announced by Speaker David Ralston**

This week, Speaker David Ralston's (R – Blue Ridge) announced a new legislative initiative branded as Georgia's Red Tape Watch, a small business regulation review initiative. The responsibilities of the initiative will lie within the purview of the House Special Committee on Small Business and will be chaired by Rep. David Knight (R – Griffin). The committee will be responsible for reviewing current regulations on small businesses in Georgia and will make recommendations on state issues related to labor, environmental, permitting, compensation, and various other issues.
