

Welcome to the Georgia Bio Legislative Watch, a weekly update on the 2012 legislative session of the Georgia General Assembly provided by Brock Clay Attorneys exclusively for Georgia Bio members.

Georgia Bio is supporting several economic development initiatives aimed at encouraging growth and expansion of emerging life sciences companies. Below is an update on some of these:

Update on [HB 868](#) - Job Tax Credits

Rep. Doug Collins' (R - Gainesville) [HB 868](#), one of the major pieces of legislation related to the Governor's competitiveness initiative. The legislation expands the state's current job creation incentives to include companies in biomedical manufacturing. The legislation also lowers the employee threshold to qualify for the credits in certain geographic areas in Georgia. The legislation is currently in the House Ways and Means Committee. After a fiscal note came back this week with a price tag of almost \$70 million, legislative and executive staff are searching for a way to fund the legislation.

Update on [HB 718](#) - Venture Capital Fund

[HB 718](#) is sponsored by Rep. Allen Peake (R - Macon). It will set up a \$200 million venture capital fund by auctioning insurance tax credits. The fund would be overseen by a state authority and would invest in start-up or early growth technology companies. The legislation passed out of subcommittee two weeks ago and remains in the House Insurance Committee.

Alternative Investments - [SB 402](#)

Senate Retirement Chairman Tim Golden (R - Valdosta) introduced [SB 402](#). [SB 402](#) would allow for the investment of state employees retirement funds in a variety of different accounts including private investment funds, warrants, venture capital funds, leveraged buyouts, options, recapitalizations, privatizations, and mezzanine funds. The Teachers Retirement System is exempt from the provisions of the legislation.
