University of Massachusetts Medical School, in collaboration with the Home Care Aide Council, is offering another Train-the-Trainer event for organizations seeking to administer the **Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS)** and **Executive Office of Elder Affairs (EOEA) ABC's for Direct Care Workers** curriculum, a product of the MA Personal and Home Care Aide State Training (PHCAST) project. This 60-hour standardized core competency curriculum aligns with the EOEA training requirements for **homemakers** and **personal care homemakers**.
