CERTIFICATION EXAM

- Did my SANE training course meet the current IAFN **SANE Education Guidelines?**
 - minimum of 40 hours of didactic SANE Training
 - designed and offered as a contiguous course by one accredited provider
 - my certificate awarded at least 40 contact hours from an accredited provider
- Did I complete a preceptorship that meets the **Education Guidelines?**

CERTIFICATION RENEWAL

Renew by CE*

- Do I hold a current SANE certification?
- Have I accrued a minimum of 45 hours of CE over the last 3 years?
- Does the topic of each CE activity appear on the test content outline of the certification I seek to renew?
- Have I listed up to 45 Category A hours?
- Are 6 of my hours from an accredited CE provider?
- Have I listed no more than 15 Category B hours?
- Am I sure I have claimed no more than 10 hours for any single topic?

* To renew by exam, review the checklist items in the Exam column

BOTH EXAM AND RENEWAL

- Have I accrued a minimum of 300 hrs of SANE-related **practice*** in the last 3 yrs?

At least 200 of those 300 hours must comprise SANE-related practice that is focused on the certification for which the applicant intends to renew (e.g., for the SANE-A certification, at least 200 of the applicant's 300 hours must comprise SANE-related practice that is focused on the adult patient population; for the SANE-P certification, at least 200 of the applicant's 300 hours must comprise SANE-related practice that is focused on the prepubescent patient population).

- Have I read the current Certification (**Exam** or **Renewal**) Handbook?
- Have I completed the application—and saved a copy?
- Have I submitted the application and fee to arrive before the deadline?

* **“Practice” includes providing patient care, taking on-call shifts, teaching/precepting, consulting, and participating in peer review.**
