This was Lyn's last presentation of his career as he was looking forward to his retirement. We were honored that he chose to present one last time for our chapter.

In May, our 2013 Chapter scholarship award recipient, Chris Bright, presented his masters thesis topic. This technical program was very unique in that it provided a fun look at college students in the concrete industry being creative with ideas to see where it could take them. Chris's thesis was focused on a helix type of fiber-reinforcing that was developed and tested. Although, it may not be highly economical or practical at this point, the results have opened many doors for further research. Chris is hopeful their work will eventually lead to something practical and useful in the concrete repair industry and if not, maybe it can be used in other fields.
