Position Description: Full-time, 9 month fixed term fashion design lecturer position beginning August 21, 2017. Teaching areas include apparel design/product development, 3D virtual prototyping/CAD, flat pattern, beginning and intermediate design studios.

Required Qualifications: Master's degree (Ph. D preferred) in Fashion Design or a Bachelor's Degree in Fashion Design with a minimum of 6 years of appropriate industry experience.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference will be given to candidates with teaching experience and current technology skills.
