

Assistant Professor in Fashion Merchandising

- Position:** Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in FASHION MERCHANDISING, beginning August 2018. The Fashion Merchandising program offers a B.S. in the department of Human Development, Fashion, and Interior Design within the College of Health and Human Services.
- Responsibilities:** The successful candidate will have expertise to teach undergraduate courses in TEXTILES and PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT within the Fashion Merchandising major. Other instructional assignments are dependent upon academic preparation, experience, and departmental needs. Candidates will be expected to advise students in the undergraduate program, partake in committee service, engage in scholarly work in the field, and participate in related university and community services. The successful candidate may be assigned to perform work at off-campus sites and/or provide instruction through distance education.
- Qualifications:** A doctorate degree is required by the time of appointment. Expertise in **TEXTILES** and **PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT is required**. Applicants should have at least one advanced degree in fashion/apparel merchandising, textiles and clothing, or a related discipline. Apparel industry professional experience is recommended. Evidence of teaching effectiveness at the university level and apparel computer software application knowledge is highly preferred. Demonstrated commitment to pursuing an active research agenda is required. Candidates must communicate effectively and perform well during the interview(s), which may include a teaching demonstration. Candidates must enjoy working with students, as well as show scholarly competence. All applicants must be work eligible in the United States. The department seeks candidates whose research, teaching, or service has prepared them to contribute to our commitment to diversity and inclusion in higher education.
