Expectations to teach in the graduate program require evening hours, all classes are taught between the hours of 4:30 PM and 9:00 PM.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND BASIC DUTIES

- Teach 3 courses per semester for a total of 6 courses per academic year (rotating between fall, spring, summer to provide coverage all year)
- Perform academic advisement for graduate students
- Help in recruitment efforts of graduate students
- Recruit, interview and recommend adjunct professors to the Dean for hire
- Stay current with innovative teaching methods and industry developments
- Contribute to the profession through research, consulting, presentations, and/or publications
- Hold regular office hours weekly (six hours per week serving graduate students as needed)
- Work closely with students outside of the classroom as a faculty mentor
- Assist the Dean in course and program assessment as well as curriculum development
- Assist the Dean and other faculty in norming core courses
- Conduct observations of faculty as assigned by Dean
- Work closely with other faculty as a mentor and resource
- Serve on the Faculty Council and standing committees
- Contribute to college-wide programs such as Open House
- Actively engage with the field through relevant association memberships
- Work well in a team environment
- Perform other duties as assigned

REQUIREMENTS: The person selected will have the following qualifications:

Minimum Required Qualifications:

- Ph.D. required
- Knowledge of fields taught within the major
- College level teaching experience
- Minimum of 3 years teaching experience

Preferred Qualifications:

- Graduate teaching experience preferred
- Preference will be given to candidates with fashion/business industry experience
