Description and Responsibilities:

Applications are invited for a tenure-track position as Assistant or Associate Professor in The Department of Design, Housing and Merchandising (DHM) in the College of Human Sciences at Oklahoma State University, in the area of fashion design and textiles. The starting date is August 2018. The position supports the departmental strategic vision to partner with industry and the community as recognized leaders in technology and sustainability in both teaching and research productivity.

The successful candidate will:

- TEACH
-courses in fashion design and construction
-textile sciences
- ADVISE
-undergraduate and graduate students
- ENGAGE
-students in design competitions, research projects, technology, student professional development, and global studies
- RESEARCH
-develop or continue a program of research/scholarship in the area of fashion design and textiles using technology, disseminate scholarly work through peer-reviewed journals and other outlets, seek external funding through proposal writing
- OUTREACH
-participate in community projects, training sessions, presentations and other opportunities involving the citizens of Oklahoma

The department seeks an innovative individual who will contribute to and collaborate with faculty teams on both teaching and research innovations. The scholarly work must be integrated into teaching activities to inspire and prepare the upcoming professionals to lead the apparel industry into the future.

The successful candidate must have interest in engaging with curriculum development, assessment of student learning, committee service, community engagement with constituents off campus, and participating in professional organizations.

Qualifications:

- Earned Ph.D. with specialization in the area of fashion design and textiles, conferred no later than the starting date of the appointment.
- Knowledge of emerging technologies and processes in fashion design and textiles is requisite
- A demonstrated record of activity in fashion design competitions and participating in exhibitions is preferred along with an ability to work effectively with students, co-workers and administrative personnel.

Appointment:

The position is a nine-month, tenure-track position with responsibilities in teaching, research and service to fulfill the land-grant mission of Oklahoma State University.
