

**Tenure Track Assistant Professor/Professor of Practice in Fashion Design, Syracuse University School of Design, College of Visual and Performing Arts**

Tenure-track Assistant Professor: Faculty must be committed to teaching and engaging in research scholarship or creative activity. Candidates should be accomplished in professional practice; have a minimum of three to five years of successful university-level (undergraduate or graduate, up to 3:3 load) teaching and who have a record of exploration and innovation. Qualifications: Terminal degree in Fashion, Design or related discipline (Ph.D., MFA, or equivalent). The preferred candidate will have at least one degree in fashion and professional and/or academic experience in teaching fashion or a related field.

Professor of Practice: Faculty must be committed to teaching and engaging in research scholarship or creative activity to inform their teaching. Candidates should demonstrate success in professional practice; have a minimum of three years successful university-level (undergraduate or graduate, up to 4:4 load) teaching and who have a record of exploration and innovation. Qualifications: Terminal degree in Fashion, Design or related discipline (MFA, or equivalent experience). The preferred candidate will have at least one degree in fashion and professional and/or academic experience in teaching fashion or a related field, and industry and/or business experience and connections.

Knowledge of collection development, industry standard sewing and sewing equipment, fashion sketching, pattern development, computer generated pattern making, draping, textiles and Adobe Creative Suite strongly preferred. Experience and ongoing relationships with the fashion industry is required.
