**Position Summary** 

The John and Doris Norton School of Family and Consumer Sciences (hereinafter referred to as the "School") seeks an Assistant/Associate Professor of Practice to teach traditional and online courses in the Retailing and Consumer Sciences program (hereinafter referred to as "RCSC"). This 12-month teaching position (1.0 FTE) principally involves course development for the RCSC online curriculum, teaching RCSC courses online through UAOnline in the fall, spring, and summer semesters, teaching RCSC courses as needed in traditional format, and varied service related duties. The open position is non-tenure eligible, with renewable one-year contract. The position allows for opportunities to advance in rank (Assistant to Associate; Associate to Full). The position will start on or before July 1, 2017.

The schedule of RCSC courses to be taught will be dependent upon course assignments which are subject to change from semester to semester. Expected teaching load ranges between 6-7 courses per year. Teaching will be largely in the RCSC online program. Notwithstanding, any required traditional courses will be on the main campus for the University of Arizona.

#### **Duties & Responsibilities**

The successful candidate will be expected to do the following:

- Teach six (6) to seven (7) courses during a calendar year with primary focus on the RCSC UAOnline program. Courses presently in need of staffing include, without limitation, Introduction to Retailing, Retail Business Analysis and Decision Making, Retail Math, Consumer Behavior, and Supply Chain Management;
- In conjunction with UAOnline, develop online course curriculum for existing RCSC coursework, as directed by the Director of the School;
- Serve on academic committees as directed by the director of the School; and
- Provide additional service requirements to RCSC; for example, student club advising, and student project oversight.

**Minimum Qualifications** 

At a minimum, the successful candidate will possess the following:

- Master's degree in retailing, business, or other such related discipline;
- Industry experience in retailing, business, or other such related discipline;
- Teaching and student-mentoring experience in both traditional and online classroom settings at a college or university level;
- Demonstrated ability to design college/university-level curriculum; and
- Demonstrated instructional design ability to develop online course curriculum.
