

## 2005 ITAA Fellow – Nancy (Fair) Rutherford



Dr. Nancy J. Fair of the University of Tennessee was named Fellow of ITAA at the 2005 annual meeting in Alexandria, VA. Dr. Fair has been involved with ITAA in leadership levels for 18 years, serving most recently as President. She was the Prentice Hall lecturer in 2004 and has served ITAA with vision and a creative ability which allows her to see and pursue innovative issues.
