Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

- The Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) applies to all educational materials available on the ITAA *Teaching Collection* (The Collection) web pages.
- All users of the ITAA *Teaching Collection* web pages must comply.
- Educational materials are provided in the spirit of collaboration between ITAA members for the purpose of improving teaching and learning across all areas of ITAA.
- All materials accessible through The Collection's web pages are available only for personal and non-commercial use.
- ITAA will use the Intellectual Property (IP) protection policies of the Creative Commons consortium (<http://creativecommons.org>).
- Under Creative Commons licensing, all materials posted on the ITAA *Teaching Collection* web pages are freely available for ITAA members to use, without prior permission, so long as the terms of the appropriate Creative Commons license are adhered to.
- In general, Creative Commons licenses require:
 - **Attribution** – Users should always attribute the creators of the materials (IP) they are using;
 - **Non-Commercial Use** – Users may not use, or knowingly permit, IP obtained from the ITAA Teaching Networks web pages for commercial purposes.

Violations

- Providing fee-based materials on The Collection web pages.
- Using materials available on The Collection web pages to make fraudulent offers to buy or sell The Collection's educational materials.
- Using The Collection's educational teaching and learning resources without adhering to the Creative Commons license requirements of the respected materials: Attribution and Non-Commercial Use.
