George DeVane, CRNA (\$1,000)	<p>Additional Criteria</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Only students enrolled in a KS CRNA program currently certified by COA 2. CRNAs working toward their degree are not eligible 3. Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale 4. Preference to 2nd year students, if none 1st year eligible 5. Students given preference with greater economic need if other criteria satisfied

Patricia Devine (\$300)	<p>Additional Criteria</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. MSN in psychiatric nursing 2. Established career in psychiatric nursing in Kansas working on BSN 3. If no applicant meets above criteria, it may be awarded at the discretion of the KNF scholarship committee

RNs with other equal graduate program 7. Remain a KSNA member
KSNA District 2 (\$500)	<p>Additional Criteria</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Reside in Johnson, Leavenworth, or Wyandotte counties for at least one year

Nursing school, BSN intent to practice medical-surgical or acute care nursing 3. Nursing school, i.e. ADN with intent for Gerontological nursing 4. RN seeking certification in medical-surgical nursing by ANCC 5. RN seeking national conference on nursing diagnosis and/or patient quality of care focus

Applicant must reside in Western Kansas (west of U.S. Highway 81) 2. Admitted to Kansas MSN-FNP program 3. Kansas RN to practice one year in rural (federally designated) Kansas town as a FNP 4. If none of above pertain, CNS, CNM, or CRNA to practice one year in rural (federally designated) Kansas 5. Recipient to submit narrative of how funds will be/were beneficial in the education process and highlight rural practice
Elizabeth See Research Grant (\$300)	<p>Criteria</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A KSNA member requesting funds to conduct nursing-directed research including thesis and dissertations 2. Scientific work can include historical, descriptive, empirical, and experimental projects
