SCR 3.635 Kentucky Law Update seminars in each appellate district

(1) Each educational year, the Commission shall conduct a 12 credit continuing legal education seminar in each Supreme Court District. Subjects taught at each seminar shall include the latest Kentucky Supreme Court and Court of Appeals decisions, procedural rule changes, Federal Court decisions, legal ethics, professional responsibility and professionalism, Kentucky statutory changes and other subjects relating to improvements in basic legal skills. Each program shall include a minimum of 2 credits for subjects specifically addressing legal ethics, professional responsibility and professionalism.

(2) Registration for the Kentucky Law Update seminars shall be free to all members in good standing with the Association.

(3) Members may attend Kentucky Law Update seminars in any location. The maximum credit that may be earned for attending any 1 Kentucky Law Update seminar is 12 credits. However, if different tracks of programs are attended at different locations, additional credit may be approved by the Commission. Duplicate credits shall not be earned by attending the same program at different locations.
