Job Title: TerraCorps Service Member

Salary/Compensation: Members receive a living stipend of \$6,315 (pre-tax) over the 6-month term of service, which is \$526.25 per 24 biweekly pay periods. They also receive an education award of \$2,960 (pre-tax) and additional AmeriCorps benefits.

Location of position: We have 4 open positions- Roxbury, Lincoln, Lowell, and Springfield, MA.

Employer: TerraCorps (Mount Grace Land Conservation Trust)

Description of employer: TerraCorps is an innovative national service program helping communities conserve and secure land for the health and well-being of people and nature.

Work schedule: Mostly M-F, 9-5 with some nights and weekends.

General Job description: This winter we are looking for 4 members to serve in full-time, 24-week (900 hour) positions. Interested individuals can apply to serve with Gardening the Community (Springfield) as a Land Stewardship Coordinator, New Entry Sustainable Farming Partnership (Lowell) as a Community Engagement Coordinator, Urban Farming Institute (Roxbury) as a Regional Conservation Coordinator, or The Walden Woods Project (Lincoln) as a Youth Education Coordinator.

These 900 hour AmeriCorps positions receive a living allowance, education award, and additional AmeriCorps benefits. Members will join our current 2017-2018 TerraCorps team and serve from 2/12/18 – 7/27/18.

Application specifics, position descriptions, and information about organizations hosting TerraCorps members can be found at terracorps.org. Applications will be accepted until all positions are filled. Interviews begin mid-January, and we aim to fill all positions by February 5th, 2018.

AmeriCorps programs provide equal service opportunities. TerraCorps will recruit and select persons in all positions to ensure a diverse and inclusive climate without regard to any particular status. We encourage applications from individuals with disabilities and will provide reasonable accommodations for interviews and service upon request. No medical screening is required.

Qualifications: As a program of AmeriCorps, Terracorps applicants must also meet the following AmeriCorps requirements:

- A US citizen, US national, Lawful Permanent Resident Alien of the U.S. and/or tribal member
- At least 18 years old
- A minimum of a high school diploma or GED
- No more than three previous terms as an AmeriCorps member
- Pass a criminal history background check, including an FBI check

Deadline to apply: The position starts on February 12th, 2018. Interested individuals are encouraged to apply as soon as possible.
