Members on the panel will discuss their roles and responsibilities in dealing with individuals in the criminal justice system who present with symptoms and diagnoses of a mental illness. Panelists will discuss de-escalation and communication techniques when encountering the mentally ill person on the street and at the time of law enforcement intervention. Panelists will discuss the challenges presented when prosecuting, and defending, a mentally ill defendant when Rule 20 is invoked. Finally, panelists will discuss the commitment process when a defendant is found incompetent to stand trial under Rule 20.
