Position Title: Assistant County Attorney
Department: Martin County Attorney's Office

Education/Minimum Requirements: Juris Doctor degree; Admission to Minnesota State Bar, License to practice law in the State of Minnesota; Yearly Continuing Legal Education requirements as directed by the Minnesota Supreme Court; Current Minnesota driver's license; Must pass criminal background checks necessary to obtain CJDN access authorization pursuant to BCA rules

Position: Full time, salaried, at-will position working a minimum of 40 hours per week, but hours may exceed these minimum hours on occasion

Salary: Starting salary is dependent upon qualifications and experience, with salary step increases and a competitive benefit package

Desired Qualifications: Experience working as an Assistant County Attorney or City Attorney, experience as a Judicial Law Clerk and/or prosecution related experience.

The Assistant County Attorney serves at the pleasure of the County Attorney, and is required to administer and enforce the laws of the State of Minnesota and its political subdivision. Primary areas of responsibility include but are not limited to felony, gross misdemeanor and misdemeanor criminal prosecutions, juvenile law, child protection law, child support, and general civil practice in all of the courts of the State.
