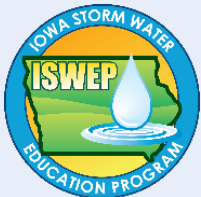
## Iowa Certified Construction Site Pollution Prevention Inspector (ICCSPPPI) Program

### Certification

Attend ICCSPPI training, pass the written exam and sign the Code of Ethics to become a Certified ICCSPPI. ICCSPPIs are recognized statewide for their credentials to conduct pollution prevention inspections at construction sites. Your name will also be added to the Certified ICCSPPI database is located on the ISWEP website at [www.IowaStormwater.org](http://www.IowaStormwater.org)

### Recertification

Certified ICCSPPIs must attend a half-day refresher workshop every 3 years to remain certified.



### Cancellation Policy

Full refund or credit of registration fee if cancellation notification is received three or more working days prior to event; 50% refund if notice is received less than three working days prior to event and no refund or credit is given for no notification / no-shows the day of event except in extenuating circumstances. Registration is transferable.
