SB 272 Compliance

As reported to you in our winter newsletter, MISAC members are hard at work on an app to satisfy the new SB 272, California Public Records Act requirements for local government. SB 272 requires that local agencies create a catalog of enterprise systems used and that information be made publicly available on the agency's website.

Charles Kalil of Garden Grove and Mike Allen of Visalia are testing an app that has been developed to help MISAC members comply with this new law. Once the app is tested with a small group to ensure proper functionality, it will be rolled out to the membership. The app is expected to be available by the end of April.
