

PRESIDENT-ELECT

Term Length:

One year. Term commences at the beginning of the first fiscal year following election as President-Elect. This office is the first in a trilogy of annual offices; the second of which is that of President, and the third of which is that of Past President.

Duties and Responsibilities:

In the absence of the President, act in the official capacity of the Association.

To become informed and oriented to the structure and operations of the Association so as to be effective during his/her presidential term.

The President-Elect serves as a liaison to library-related organizations, such as: the Minnesota Library Association Institute for Leadership Excellence (MILE), St. Catherine University MLIS Advisory Council, and St. Catherine University ALA Student Chapter.

Serve as a voting member of the MLA Board of Directors.

Serve on the MLA Executive Committee.

Conduct annual performance review of Executive Director with the Executive Committee.

Serve on the MLA Budget and Finance Committee.

Serve on the MLA Bylaws and Policy Committee.

Serve as Chair of the MLA Annual Conference Sponsors Committee.
