2017 MUNICIPAL MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

The Missouri Public Water Council (MPWC) has been organized for municipalities owning or operating drinking water and/or wastewater systems for their citizens. The MPWC charter provides:

“Each member may name one voting delegate to the Council. Alternatively, it may name separate delegates for its drinking water system and its wastewater system if it operates both categories of systems; and such delegates shall each cast one-half vote. The member may name alternates to vote in place of its delegate(s) in the case of a delegate’s absence, and either delegate of a member with two delegates may act as alternate for the other if authorized by the member.

The Public Water Council shall have responsibility for:

- Developing and advocating recommended public policy with respect to state and federal regulation of drinking water and water quality;
- Serving as a forum for its members’ consultation on matters concerning the ownership and operation of drinking water and wastewater systems;
- Developing and overseeing an expenditure plan for all funds budgeted by the Association for Council activity and for such additional funds as the Council may generate to support its activities; and
- Overseeing all staff and consultant activities relating to its enumerated functions and to the support of members’ drinking water and wastewater operations.”
