## HOUSE AND SENATE CONFERENCE ON THE WRDA BILLS NEARING COMPLETION WITH FLOOR VOTES EXPECTED NEXT WEEK IN BOTH CHAMBERS

House and Senate staff conference negotiations on the Water Resources Development Act of 2016 have been ongoing this week with a conclusion anticipated by end of this week or early next week. House and Senate floor votes could occur as soon as next week. Details of the conference negotiations are being held close to the vest. At this time, it appears that the House Republicans are insisting on resolving the Corps of Engineers issues that are in both bills and deflecting the "EPA issues" in the Senate bill. The Senate and House Democrats are concerned that the conference participants will reach an agreement on the Corps of Engineers issues but will run out of time to resolve the EPA issues. Coalition representatives continue to make it known to key conference staff that the Coalition supports the Senate language on the voluntary labeling/fee proposal and other water related provisions of interest and to advocate from the House's side, inclusion of many of the provisions contained in Congressman DeFazio's omnibus water bill such as reauthorization of the Clean Water SRF and the Alternative Water Source Projects Program.

Coalition representatives will continue to meet with conference staff and vigorously advocate for noted Senate provisions to be included in the final WRDA bill.
