 - a. Research design
 - b. Sampling and data collection
 - c. Measurement and instrumentation
3. Results and Conclusions
 - a. Specific and succinct outcomes and key findings
 - b. Implications for social work practice and policy regarding African Americans and the diaspora
 - c. Future research directions
