Social Workers Impairment: Behaviors That May Reflect Active Addictive Disease

- 1. Unusual behavior at work
- 2. Inappropriate behavior toward:
 - Staff
 - Clients or patients
 - Colleagues
- 3. Mood swings
- 4. Poor judgment
- 5. Declining quality of performance
- 6. Decline in physical appearance and personal grooming
- 7. Increase in physical complaints
- 8. Frequent physical or emotional illness
- 9. Withdrawal from friends and colleagues
- 10. Change in usual work schedule:
 - Frequently late
 - Always at work
 - Schedule erratic and unpredictable
- 11. Physical symptoms caused by alcohol or other substances:
 - Tremors or twitching
 - Profuse perspiration
 - Pupils dilated or constricted
 - Persisting cold like symptoms
