### Requirements

- Attend an in-person orientation on Saturday, October 1, 2016 from 10-4 in Lansing
- Attend annual Legislative, Education and Advocacy Day (LEAD) on Tuesday, October 25, 2016
- Be willing to network and communicate with your school students and faculty
- Host at least one on-campus event per year (can be in partnership with other U-Link Advocates)
