### **Assistance Sought by NFRC 101 Thermophysical Properties of Materials Task Group**

To more accurately reflect the materials and technologies used in building current and future windows, doors, and skylights, the NFRC 101 Thermophysical Properties of Materials Task Group is interested in revising and adding materials and thermophysical property data to the generic materials listings in NFRC 101.

NFRC is seeking assistance in identifying additional specific generic materials for potential inclusion in the NFRC 101 generic materials lists. These new material suggestions can represent generic materials that are notably absent or new applications of existing materials used in current or future fenestration designs.

### **Certified Products Directory (CPD)**

Within the next week, updates will be installed to the Product Line Listing Report in the CPD. This report is available to users who login as Participants or as IAs, and is accessible within the NFRC Reports tab. The updated "Product Line Listing" report will generate a PDF that can be saved or printed, with the data arranged in an easy, readable table. Users will be able to login to the CPD and print the report for their records and view important dates for both active and inactive product lines, for example, product line expiration dates. ### **2015 IECC Offers Improvement Over 2012 Version**

According to the Federal Register, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) says the 2015 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) would improve energy efficiency in buildings by about 0.87 percent compared to the 2012 version.

Each State is required to certify it has reviewed the provisions of its residential building code regarding energy efficiency and made a determination as to whether to update its code to meet or exceed the 2015 IECC.
