Subject: NFRC – Technical Bulletin 2015-07 (Information Only)

This bulletin is notification of an NFRC Board of Directors mandate regarding NFRC 201 testing.

Test reports to NFRC 201-2010 conducted *after* January 1, 2013 shall be deemed valid for use with NFRC 201-2014 and ANSI/NFRC 200-2014, on the basis that nothing has changed. Any NFRC 201 tests conducted *prior* to January 1, 2013 shall not be accepted.

This mandate was the result of a submitted Technical Interpretations Request (TIR) that could not be handled by the Technical Interpretation Policy Committee and was therefore forwarded to the NFRC Executive Committee and Board for a decision.

The TIR submitted to TIPC was TIR-2015-01 (NFRC 201 Center-of-Glass Component Testing). This TIR asked the question, "*ANSI/NFRC 200-2014 only references NFRC 201-2014 for the allowable standard to use for center of glazing (COG) SHGC testing. Can NFRC 201-2010 also be used since it and 201-2014 are equivalent?*"
