Subject: Implementation of Five-year Certification Cycle and Temporary Shutdown of APD/CPD (Information Only)

This bulletin is to notify NFRC participants that implementation of the 5-year certification cycle will begin on February 29, 2016, and not March 1, 2016, as previously published. The date of expiration for all new and recertified product lines will meet the requirements of the [NFRC 700-2016](#), Section 5.1: "Granting of Certification Authorization" and Section 5.6: "Recertification." In order to implement the modifications of the recently approved 5-year certification cycle to the NFRC Certified Products Directory (CPD)/Attachment Products Directory (APD) efficiently, the APD/CPD will be temporarily unavailable from 8:00 p.m. Friday, February 26, 2016, until 7:00 a.m., Monday, February 29, 2016 (all times are Eastern Standard Time).

Inspection agencies should be aware that there is a slight possibility that product lines queued for publication on Friday may be interrupted if the queues are very full.
