NFRC Fee Schedule for 2017 Released; Nominal Increases Implemented to Maintain Robust Programs

The National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) has released its 2017 Fee Schedule, which includes fee increases for some programs.

After assessing the 2016 program participation fees and operating expenses, the National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) Board of Directors has made a number of important changes that will impact program participants beginning January 1, 2017.

The changes to the [2017 Fee Schedule](#) include:

- NFRC 700 PCP, Site Built and Applied Film Manufacturers Program Fees increase 5%;
- Inspection Agency Licensing Fees increase to \$10,000;
- NFRC 302 IGDB/CGDB Supplies fees increase by 5%; and
- NFRC 713 IVP fees have been restructured to resemble the PCP fee structure based on company sales; annual product line IVP fees have been removed.

NFRC is sensitive to the needs of its licensees and works diligently to maintain the balance between keeping certification affordable and improving value.
