NFRC Board of Directors Election

All NFRC Board members must be active members or have a significant relationship/representation with an active member. When up for re-election or vacated, seats on the board will be described as either “specified” or “unspecified.” This refers to the required representation needed, per NFRC’s By-laws, to ensure representation of industry and public interest groups.

These broad categories are:

1. Fenestration Industry Category
2. General Interest Category
3. Laboratory Category

For this election cycle, seats for the Fenestration Industry Category (2) and the General Interest Category (2) will be up for a vote by membership. Of these seats, two are “unspecified” so that anyone from that broad category may run for that seat; the remaining two seats require representation from specific factions within the industry – **Fenestration Industry, Residential, and General Interest, Federal, State or local government energy or building code official.**

This month we are highlighting the two fenestration industry category seats, which are explained below. The unspecified nominee can be from any of the categories; the specified nominee must be from the category highlighted below.

Fenestration Industry Category. Five of the twelve board members must be primary glass manufacturers, manufacturers that sell fenestration systems for mostly commercial use, and **manufacturers that sell fenestration systems for mostly residential construction.** At least one representative for *each* of these categories shall serve on the board. When these specific seats need to be filled, they will be listed as “specified.” When called “Unspecified,” the three categories have board representation so any in the broader category may be nominated.
