Item 1: Publication and Implementation of NFRC 700-2011_E0A0

The following document was approved by the Board of Director, [NFRC 700-2011_E0A0](#), (NFRC Product Certification Program document) which is implemented upon publication. The modifications from the version E0A2 (2010) were too numerous to post in an addendum log, therefore the [NFRC 700-2011_E0A0 Addendum log](#) contains a list of the modifications and the [NFRC 700-2010_E0A2 Redline.pdf](#) is the entire E0A2 document with ALL modifications, which can be accessed on the NFRC Website at: <http://www.nfrc.org/programdocs2.aspx>.

Here is a summary of the modifications:

- Fenestration Manufacturer Certificate (FMC) – multiple sections
- Label language for non-certified products – 6.1.B
- Consistent format of the term Label Certificate – multiple sections
- Language in Appendix C was added and modified for required and optional information on all label certificates
- Protocols to re-print temporary labels – 6.4.D
- Language to identify example labels formats must conform to – Appendix B, section B.3
- Language to clarify use of a dash “-“ on the label – Appendix B, section B.10 and Figure B-10
