In 2014, restaurants account for 61,600 jobs in New Hampshire — **10%** of employment in the state.

EVERY \$1 SPENT ...

in New Hampshire's restaurants generates an additional **\$.81** in sales for the state economy.

EVERY \$1 MILLION SPENT ...

in New Hampshire's restaurants generates an additional **20.9** jobs in the state.

AND IN 2024 ...

Restaurants in New Hampshire are projected to employ **66,300** people. (**7.6%** job growth — or **4,700** jobs over 2014)


