OPA estimates that for the Association's fiscal year 9/1/15 to 8/31/16, 20% of dues were allocated to lobbying activities and are non-deductible; OPA estimates that for the Association's fiscal year 9/1/16 to 8/31/17, 20% of dues will be allocated to lobbying expenditures and are non-deductible.
