- A current resume from the nominee
- A letter of support from the nominating party indicating why they feel their nominee has leadership potential and should attend the Leadership Academy.

Nominees must meet the following requirements:

- Degreed Librarian (must have the degree before attending program)
- Demonstrate leadership potential
- Must be willing to remain at the hotel for the duration of the Leadership Academy, including overnight
