WHEREAS, the undersigned tenders this Resolution with the understanding that the newly issued Charter is reissued under the same terms and conditions as the original Charter


THEREFORE, Be It Resolved upon the approval of this Resolution by the Executive Committee of the PDCA, a Charter shall be re-issued.
